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#1 – Matthew 26:17-20 (Bread)
#2 – Matthew 26:14-15 (3 dimes or other silver coins)
#3 – John 19:5 (Purple cloth)
#4 – Matthew 27:29 (A few small twigs)
#5 – Matthew 27:26 (Strip of leather or piece of rope)
#6 – John 3:16, 17:3-4 (Heart)
#7 – John 20:25 (Nail)
#8 – Matthew 27:37 (Sign – "King of the Jews")
#9 – John 19:28-30 (Small piece of sponge)
#10 – John 19:32-37 (Toothpick – may have to break off one end)
#11 – Matthew 27:59-60 (Rock)
#12 – Matthew 28:5-6 (Empty)
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Instructions:

These are the scriptures and small items for each egg. Number your colored plastic eggs 1-12. Put the corresponding scripture paper and item in each egg. You may have to improvise a bit if you don't have the item listed for each one. Read the scripture to find a suitable replacement item if needed.

Use these any way that suits your family. You may want to hide the eggs for the children to find. You may just want to pass around a basket with the eggs in it already. Or you may just want the eggs in a pile in the middle of the table before you begin. There is no right or wrong way to use these.

The main idea is to convey the Easter story and talk about how it can affect or change your life and the lives of your grandchildren.

🔰 Matthew 26:17-20

Jesus had a last supper with his disciples and gave them a way to remember him with the sacrament. How do you remember him?



Matthew 26:14-15

Jesus knew that one of his disciples would betray him. How did Jesus react to his betrayal?



🔞 John 19:2,5

The men who were guarding Jesus made fun of him being a king. So they put a purple robe on him like a king would wear. How would you treat Jesus if you were guarding him?



Matthew 27:29

Jesus had a woven crown of thorns put upon his head. Do you think that Jesus still loved the men who did this to him?



Matthew 27:26

Jesus was scourged before he was handed over to be crucified. What can we do to show love when we are being mistreated?



6 John 3:16, 17:3-4

God sent his son as a gift to us. Jesus came to earth to do his Father's will. He loved us all so he gave his life for us. How can we show God that we are thankful for his gift?



V John 20:25

The people who crucified Jesus, nailed him to the cross so he would die. They did this because they were afraid of him. Why do you think they were afraid of him?



🤞 Matthew 27:37

They put a sign up on Jesus' cross. What did the sign say and what did it mean?



ಠ John 19:28-30

Jesus didn't ask for much, but he said he was thirsty. What did the soldiers give him to drink?



10hn 19:32-37

After Jesus had died, the soldiers stuck a spear in his side to be sure. What prophecy did this fulfill?



Matthew 27:59-66

A a very large stone was rolled in front of Jesus' tomb and they set guards to watch it. Why did they do this?




10 Matthew 28:5-6

These toppers fit bags of various sizes. Use these bag toppers as needed.


Instructions for Bag Toppers:






Play Dough Mat - Bugs Decorate the Butterfly and the Caterpillar




Play Dough Mat - Bunny Face Decorate the Bunny's Face




Play Dough Mat - Easter Basket Decorate the Easter Basket






Play Dough Mat - Marshmallow Peep
